## GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATIONS FOR RECOGNITION OF COURSES (ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATION)

The document should cover the following topics:

- 1. Name of institution
- 2. Qualification title (example Postgraduate diploma in disability studies)
- 3. Qualification type (example Postgraduate diploma/ degree/ Masters or PHD)
- 4. Offering type: (Full time or Part Time)
- 5. Duration (minimum 1 year)
- 6. Total credit value (minimum120 credits)
- 7. Entrance requirements
- 8. Modules/ subjects diagram (course codes and course description to be used)
- 9. Syllabus
- 10. Fieldwork (If applicable)
  - \* Total number of hours
  - \* Describe structure for each year, hour allocation for each placement
  - \* Clearly indicate hours of fieldwork in each field of practice per year of study/should alternate placement method be used, please describe).
- 11. Examinations
  - Examinations per level/year of study or per module

## CRITERIA THAT WILL BE USED TO JUDGE THE REGISTRABILITY OF THE QUALIFICATION

- Peer reviewed and evidence based if applicable
- Formal accreditation process
- Qualification must be offered by an Accredited HEI
- Qualifications obtained out of South Africa requires SAQA approval
- Qualification is within the scope of profession regulated by the OCP Board
